As a licensed Medicare and Medicaid community Maple Crest offers a variety of care options, including skilled nursing, short term rehabilitation, memory support services, hospice and respite care. We have a long and proud history of high quality care provided by a staff that is second to none.

In order to best serve our current and future residents the Maple Crest Advisory Board has developed a long-range plan to dramatically upgrade our facility. The following information describes the proposed projects and the estimated costs involved.

Addition of a new Transitional Care Unit :: \$1.523M

What is Transitional Care?

Transitional Care is beneficial for patients who require a regimen of intensive therapy or treatment following an acute hospital stay or injury/ailment. It is ideal for patients who are too ill and/or technology-dependent to receive home care, but who do not need to remain in a hospital.

What renovations/upgrades will be included?

- 19 additional beds
- Remodeled resident rooms with bathrooms
- On-unit therapy area, dining room, spa room and living room
- New furnishings

Expansion of the Memory Support Neighborhood :: \$1.715M

What is a Memory Support Neighborhood?
Maple Crest's Memory Support Neighborhoods are dedicated to meeting the needs of individuals with Alzheimer's and other dementias, as well as providing support services for their families.

What renovations/upgrades will be included?

- Expansion from 16 to 34 beds (1 new neighborhood)
- Remodeled resident rooms with bathrooms
- Remodeled on-unit living rooms and dining rooms
- New on-unit spa rooms
- New furnishings

Creation of Long Term Care Neighborhoods :: \$7.604M

What are Long Term Care Neighborhoods?

Long Term Care Neighborhoods are vastly improved living quarters for our residents. These smaller, home-like settings will give residents increased privacy while providing a higher quality, resident-centered living environment.

What renovations/upgrades are needed?

- 92 bed renovation (4 households)
- Remodeled resident rooms with bathrooms
- Remodeled therapy area, dining rooms, spa rooms, living rooms
- Renovated resident courtyard
- Elevator replacement
- Roof replacement
- Parking lot repair

TOTAL PROJECT COSTS :: \$10.842M

THE PLAN
