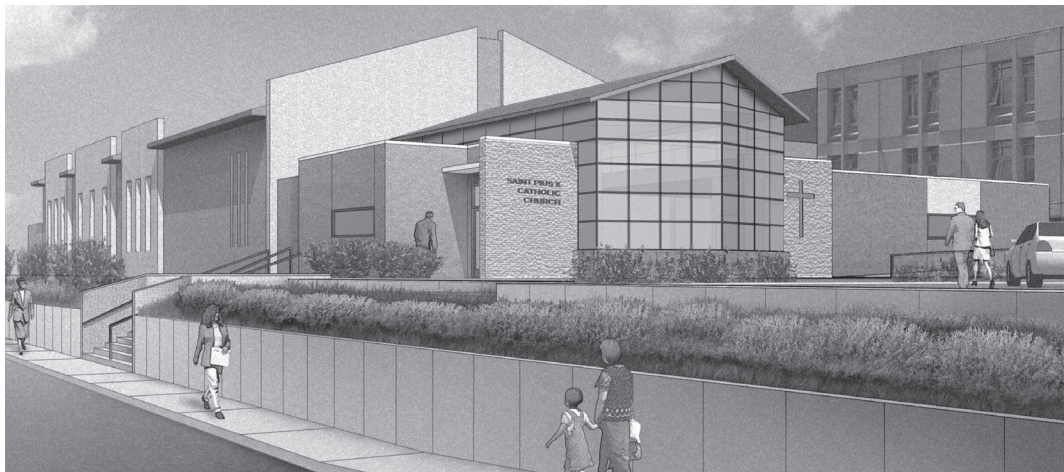

Our Future

Based on feedback from parishioners and parish leadership, the Church Planning Task Force has recommended we embark on a church campaign to retire our debt. Bank loans were needed to complete the renovation, addition, storage facility and finishes to the church. Through this major fundraising effort, it is our goal to pay off the balance that remains on these loans. If we retire this debt within the next 5 years, St. Pius X will realize a savings of approximately 1 million dollars in interest charges. We cannot wait; the time to retire the debt is now.
